Last year I made Peanut Butter Pupcakes but this year I went a little more crazy and made her these Beef and Bacon Pupcakes that I found on Pinterest.

Of course, she weighs 40 lbs., so tackling a normalsized cupcake was easy for her, if you want to make this treat and your pups on the smaller side, try giving them a smaller serving.

Ingredients

For Cupcakes:

2 cups all-purpose flour

1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder

2/3 cup butter, softened

1/2 cup extra virgin olive oil

1 jar of strained beef baby food

3 large eggs

7 slices bacon, cooked and crumbed

For Icing:

1/2 cup peanut butter

1/2 cup cream cheese, softened

Instructions

Step 1: Gather all ingredients together and preheat the

oven to 350°.

Step 2: Stir flour and baking powder together in a large mixing bowl.

Step 3: Add the butter, oil, baby food, and eggs to the mixing bowl and stir.

Step 4: Sir in the bacon bits.

Step 5: Spoon mixture into cupcake wrappers.

Step 6: Once oven is preheated, bake pupcakes for 20-25 minutes, or until done.

Step 7: While pupcakes are baking, combine peanut butter and cream cheese in a mixing bowl to make the icing.

Step 8: Put icing mixture.

Step 9: (optional) Place a heart shaped treat on top of pupcake.
